



## TCS Baseball Lodging Program

Triple Crown works with a wide variety of lodging partners in our tournament locations to secure excellent lodging rates for all participants and to ensure sufficient rooms for all attending teams. Through our lodging program, all out-of-town teams must book their rooms through Triple Crown Lodging Partners and receive specially discounted rates at a variety of hotels. We have a list of preferred partners for the Triple Crown Basketball events. To be eligible to play in this Triple Crown event all teams must book within the TCS Block, you **MUST** book your rooms by contacting the Hotel Property direct from the phone number listed on the tournament webpage under the lodging link. **A minimum of 12 room nights per team is required** (i.e. 6 rooms for 2 nights). Teams **MUST** submit their completed team hotel/condo compliance report which includes a rooming list with confirmation numbers, name of property, check-in and check-out dates no later than July 1, 2022 on the **Report Your Teams Lodging on the Tournament webpage under the "Report Lodging" red button**

### Alternative Lodging Requirement & or none reporting teams

If your team selects to stay with a non-Triple Crown Lodging Partner outside the TCS Lodging Program (for example, to stay at an RV park, with nearby relatives, non-Triple Crown lodging partner, book through a third party provider (i.e. Hotels.com, Expedia, Hotwire etc.) and or your team chooses not to report your lodging your team will incur a lodging surcharge of \$250.

### Local Teams

Teams within a 100-mile drive radius will receive a WAIVER on the lodging policy.

### Policies

Your team must complete one of the following categories:

- Stay with a TCS lodging partner inside of the group block (**minimum team requirement is 12 room nights per team. example: 6 hotel rooms for 2 nights**). Teams must submit a complete team rooming list with confirmation numbers, arrival dates and departure dates to the Triple Crown Website event lodging page.
  - Stay with a non-TCS Lodging Partner, thus not meeting the minimum 12 room night requirement and incurring a lodging surcharge of *\$250 (due by team's 1<sup>st</sup> game day)*. Teams must submit their team lodging information with name of lodging property, number of rooms, arrival dates and departure dates to the Triple Crown Website lodging page.
